





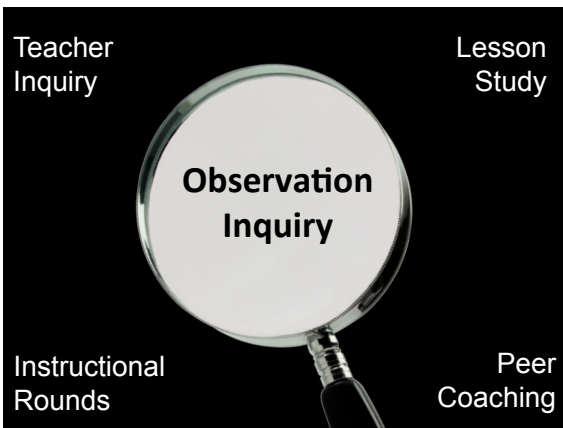

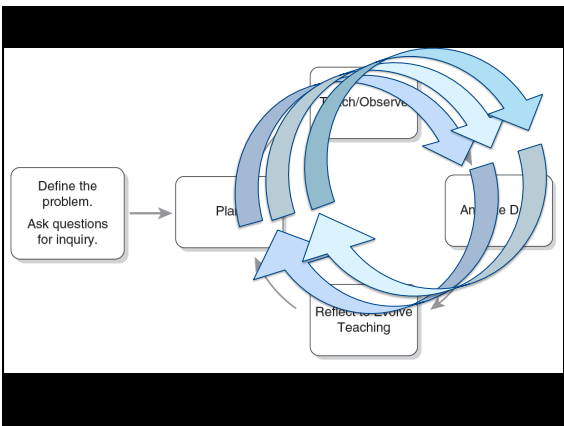




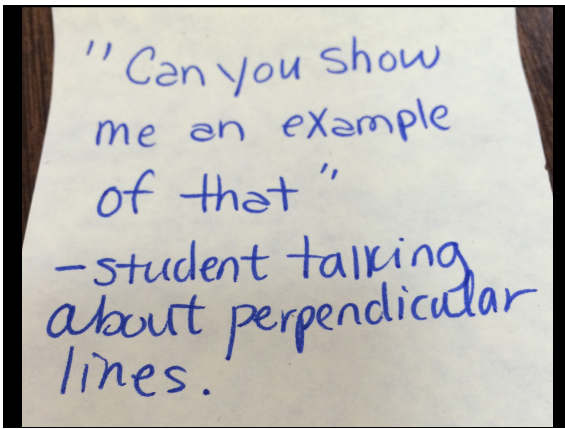












Teacher used think-pair-share.

Partners each said one idea using the sentence frame then were quiet.


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Students used iPads to annotate a digital text.
