- This is key! Don't forget what it means to be in the role of a principal. Yes everyone is accountable. It is essential to really select the right individuals. I agree know your role! This is a District responsibility. Everyone is not able to Coach! The selection process is critical! Get the right people in the role!
- Coming to that common understanding of what high quality instruction is and looks like is vital
- I was a principal coach before becoming a principal supervisor! The coach experience was very valuable!
