## **Cohort 3 MTP**

My Teaching Partner Secondary MTP-S is a multi-year partnership with the American Institutes of Research (AIR) and Teachstone CLASS to study the effects of a one-on-one CLASS video coaching model. The cyclical, strengths-based, MTP-S model involves co-planning lessons with a focus on specific CLASS indicators, followed by teacher strategy practice and lesson video recording. The cycle includes teacher response to video clips of effective interactions which "push" student learning and goal setting to continue and expand on effective practices throughout the school year.

We are currently recruiting 7-12th grade Math and English teachers to participate in Cohort Three.
