



Nirvani Budhram is currently a Senior Program Officer at the Robin Hood Learning + Technology Fund, a collaboration between Robin Hood, Overdeck Family Foundation and Siegel Family Endowment to transform learning for low-income students with technology. Nirvani also served as a Program Officer at the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation where she managed a diverse portfolio supporting innovation in K-12 education. Her leadership in grantmaking provided new partnerships between charter schools and public school systems to share best practices on teacher development, increased application of research in creating technology driven professional learning solutions, and created new models of technology enabled supports to teachers and students. Previously, she was an executive on the national staff of Expeditionary Learning Schools Outward Bound, a leading content-rich learning model, where she managed strategic programmatic and organizational growth. Nirvani was part of the start-up team at the Grow Network, which was acquired by McGraw-Hill, with the mission to transform assessment results into instructional tools for teachers, principals, and parents.
