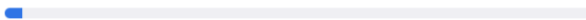

30/30 (100%) answered

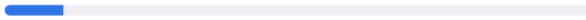
We are fully prepared and ready to go! (1/30) 3%



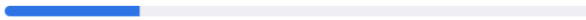
Planning is underway and seems to be going well. (19/30) 63%



OMG...summer is coming so fast! We're not ready! (3/30) 10%



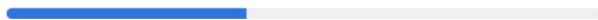
Other or not sure (7/30) 23%

30/30 (100%) answered

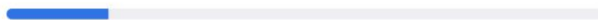
Our community partners are key stakeholders. (12/30) 40%
