The Learning Forward Team Grant

This grant supports grade-level, school, or district teams in an effort to advance Learning Forward's purpose. The grant awards up to \$10,000 to support achievement of a challenging goal aligned with Learning Forward's purpose and may include registration fees for team members to attend Learning Forward Annual and Summer Conferences.

Lynne Chidley Academy Fund

This scholarship fund develops leadership in the field of professional learning by providing two scholarships annually to participate in the Learning Forward Academy. The Academy is an extended and profound learning experience that models the organization's vision for professional learning and teamwork in schools. Both scholarships are for educators working with large populations of underserved students. One scholarship is for a school-based teacher leader/coach who aspires to a role of leadership in the field of professional learning. The second scholarship is for a district leader responsible for professional learning at the system level.

The Principal as Bridge Builder Grant

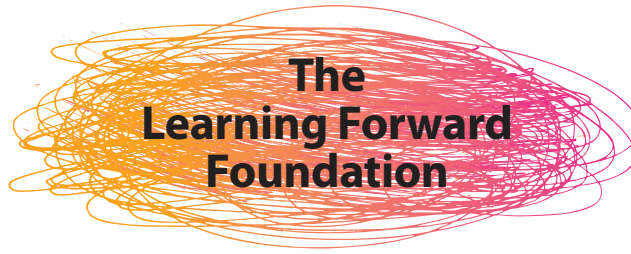
This grant fund, honoring the memory of Donald Richardson, supports the professional growth of a principal that has successfully led an underserved school for two years. It provides an opportunity to focus on enhancing leadership skills and professional growth through executive coaching and Learning Forward Annual Conference participation. Up to \$10,000 for a maximum of two years will be provided to assist the principal develop and implement a strategic administrative action plan that focuses on leadership and learning communities to improve student achievement.

The Learning Forward Affiliate Grant

This grant provides a Learning Forward affiliate organization with the opportunity to further its work within its respective state/region/province. The grant, for up to \$10,000, funds a multi-year project to allow an affiliate to create or expand its outreach and enhance its focus on professional learning that improves student achievement.
